Chapel Creek FAQs:



- Can I have an inflatable pool on my property? No, only in-ground pools are acceptable in Chapel Creek.
 However, if the public pools are closed again because of the pandemic, the board will not object to temporary pools.
- Can I have guests park on the street in front of or beside my property? No, guests must park on your driveway; however, if you are having a get-together for a special occasion, where multiple vehicles would not be able to park on the driveway, the board will not object to vehicles parked in the street. They must not be parked there overnight, however.
- Can I have signage in my yard? No, signage is prohibited unless it is a for sale or for rent sign. All other signs will be removed.
- Can I drive as fast as I want in Chapel Creek? No, the speed limit is 20 mph. Please obey it for the safety of our walkers, bikers, and children.
